

HSC Exhibitor Policies and Guidelines

Cancellation & Refund Policy

There will be a \$250 administrative fee applied to all cancellations one month before the event start date. All cancellations or requests for refunds must be made in writing and received by HSC one month prior the HSC event start date. Cancellations or requests received in the month leading up to the event will not be refunded.

Exhibitor Attendance to HSC Event Sessions/Workshops

Want to attend educational workshops? Exhibiting at HSC events does NOT include attendance for event sessions or work- shops. All exhibitors are given two booth staff passes for their exhibit/tabletop location depending on the type of space, but must register and pay as an attendee in order to attend the workshops. Registration details will be sent to exhibitors closer to the event dates.

Exhibitor Professionalism

Exhibitors at HSC events shall at all times (a) conduct business in a manner that reflects favorably on the HSC the good name, goodwill and reputation of HSC, (b) avoid deceptive, misleading or unethical practices that are detrimental to HSC and refrain from making false or misleading representations, advertisements or claims with regard to HSC and the event.
