**Program Goals are “broad statements that describe what a program intends to accomplish”**

# PROGRAM GOALS

**Develop Program Goals that are:**

Written simply

Easily understood by staff, governance, and families

Based on the work that you are actually funded to do





# **PROGRAM GOALS**

## **Must Include:**

- 1. Goals for the provision of educational, health, nutritional, and family and community engagement program services to further promote the school readiness of enrolled children**
- 2. School readiness goals**

# PROGRAM GOALS

**Must Include:**

**3. Effective health and safety practices to ensure children are safe at all times (programs may wish to identify these as a stand-alone goal or as an objective related to another type of program goal, i.e. a health goal)**

## **Goal 1**

### **PFCE**

Families will be stronger and have fewer needs.

## **Goal 2**

### **School Readiness**

Children will be ready for school.

## **Goal 3**

### **Child Health & Safety**

Children will be healthier and safer.

**To demonstrate the agency's approach to measuring progress and outcomes, program must describe data, tools, or methods for tracking progress.**

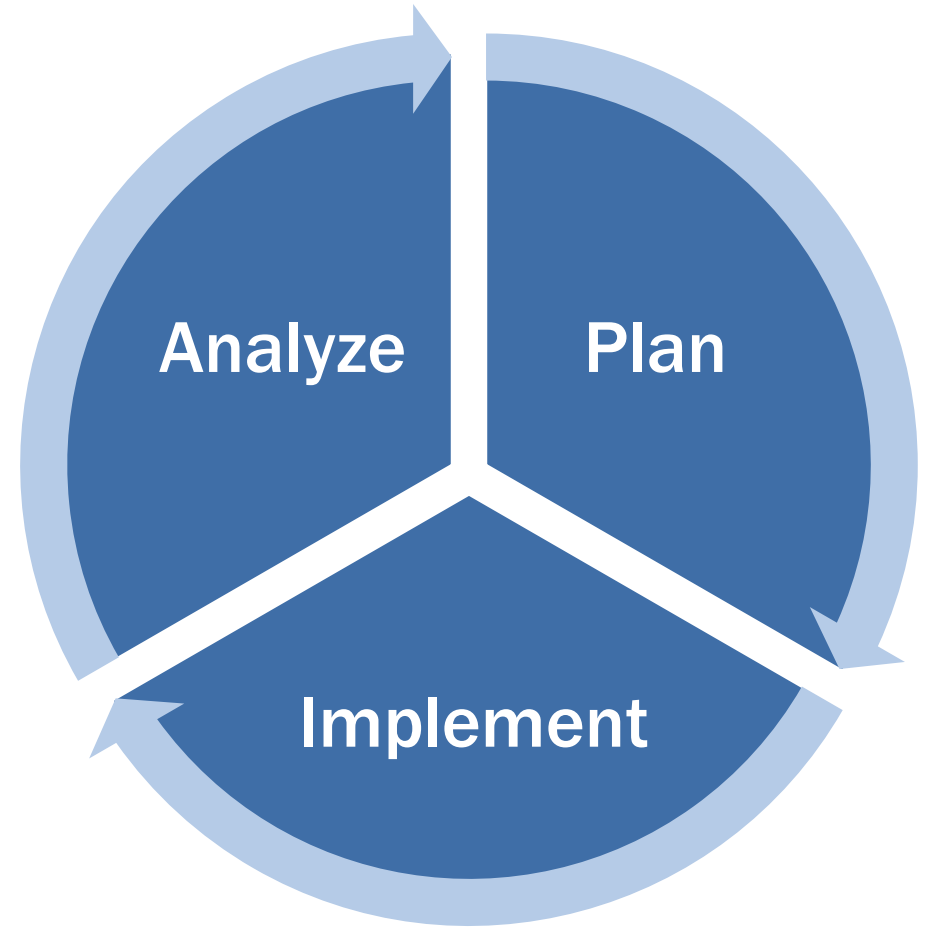

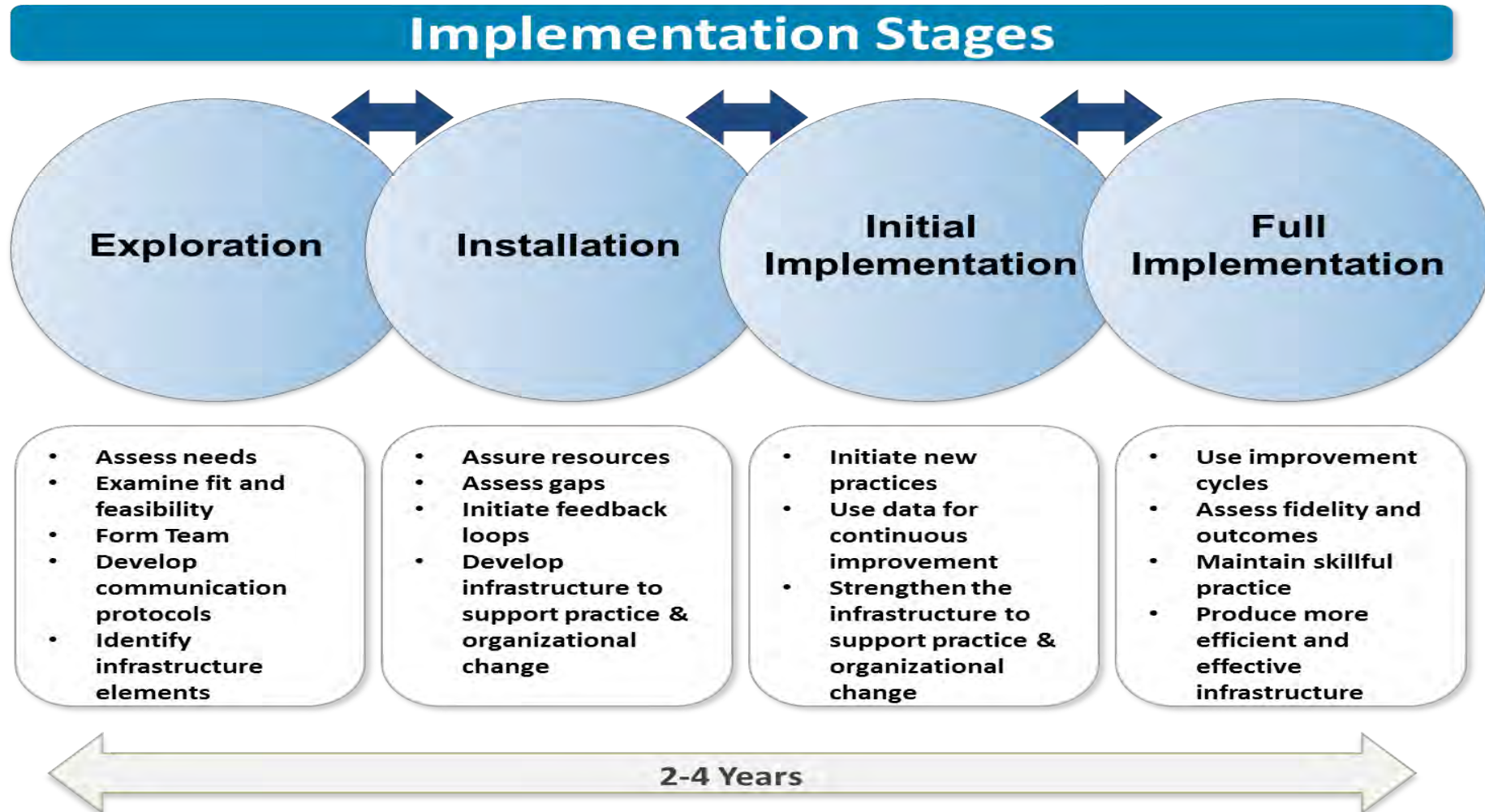

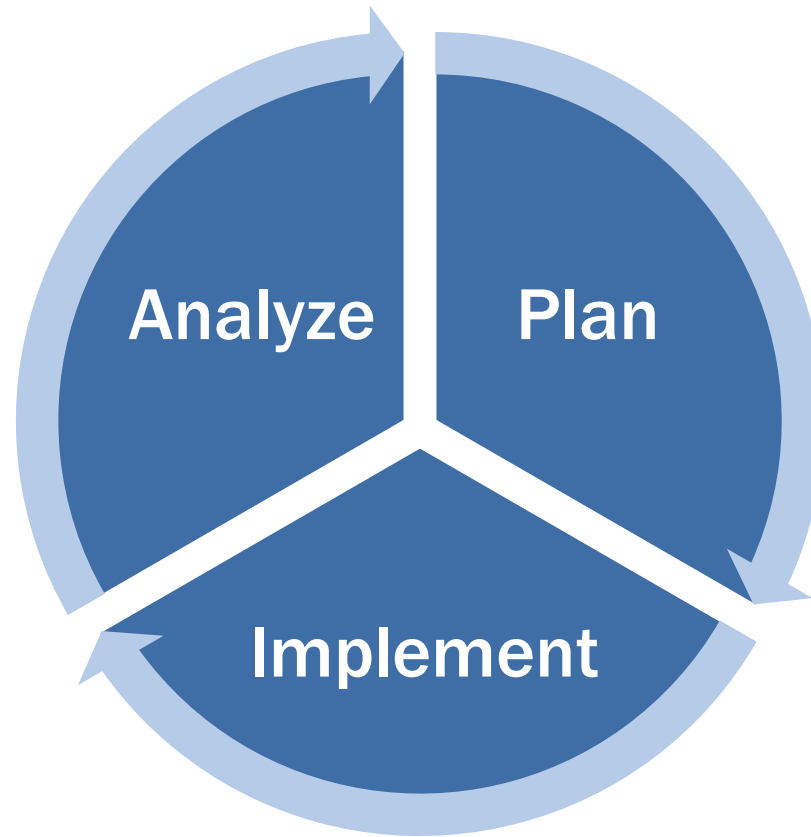
